

Fuji Corporation to start accepting orders for mobility support robot "Hug T1-02"

- Preorders for mobility support robot "Hug T1-02" will be accepted from October 2019 -

Fuji Corporation (headquarters: Chiryu, Aichi; president and COO: Mr. Shinsuke Suhara; hereafter called as "Fuji") has developed a new mobility support robot "Hug T1-02", purpose built to help those with agerelated and disability-related mobility issues in care facilities. Preorders for the "Hug T1-02" will be accepted from October 2019.

Background

The load placed on caregiving is increasing within this aging society, and the deficit of care workers is becoming more acute. As it is increasingly more common not to lift during care work, we saw a demand for a mobility support robot that meets that need. With that in mind, Fuji has developing Hug T1-02, a successor of the Hug T1-01 which was released in April 2016.

Product features

- 1. The body follows the natural trajectory of a motion to stand up, while allowing the care recipient to use their own strength as much as they are able to
- 2. Can be used immediately without the need for slings, and is easy to operate
- 3. Holds individuals in a stable position, while catering to a wider range of body types
- 4. Performs lifting work, reducing the physical burden on caregivers

Future plans

We plan to be able to ship out 60 "Hug T1-02" robots in the first year, and increase that to 360 in the following year. It is scheduled to be on sale from December. (Please inquire for prices within Japan.)
