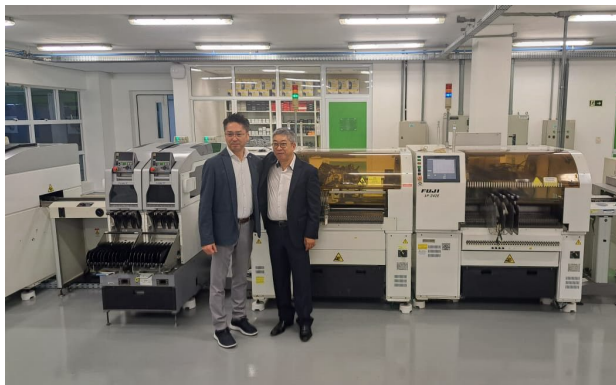


Fuji Do Brasil and Fundação Matias Machline in Partnership to Establish SMT Laboratory

Group company of FUJI CORPORATION (headquarters: Aichi, Japan; Representative Director, President & COO: Joji Isozumi; hereafter referred to as “Fuji”), Fuji Do Brasil Máquinas Industriais Ltda. (headquarters: Brazil; President: Domingos Tomyama, hereinafter referred to as “FDB”) providing sales and after-sales support for SMT equipment, has joined in partnership with the largest non-profit social education project in Brazil, [Fundação Matias Machline](#) (hereinafter referred to as “FMM”) to establish an SMT laboratory, and have loaned Fuji SMT equipment, including SMT pick and place machines required for producing electronic circuit boards, to the program free of charge.

FMM aims to promote social transformation through quality education and provides free education in technical fields to young people from economically disadvantaged backgrounds. Many students from high schools run by FMM have gone on to university in Brazil and have subsequently started working as engineers. FMM's SMT laboratory, to which Fuji's SMT equipment has been installed, will be used to educate young engineers who will support the future development of Brazil's electronics industry as a place to gain practical experience assembling electronic devices using surface mount technology.
