

## Fuji Receives First-Ever B Score in Climate Change and B-Score in Water Security in CDP 2024 Assessment

*Fuji's efforts to reduce environmental impact throughout the value chain and strengthen its sustainability response through cross-divisional initiatives were highly evaluated, resulting in a four-level improvement from the previous year's D score (disclosure level) to a B score (at the management level).*

In an assessment conducted by CDP, a global non-profit organization that operates an environmental disclosure system, covering more than 24,800 companies worldwide, Fuji Corporation (headquarters: Chiryu, Aichi; Representative Director, President and CEO: Joji Isozumi; hereinafter referred to as "Fuji") has for the first time received a "B" score, the third highest possible, in Climate Change and a "B-", the fourth highest possible, in Water Security.

Fuji has actively addressed the global challenge of environmental sustainability. In this year's environmental disclosure survey, the company's efforts to not only further strengthen the sustainability promotion framework but also reduce environmental impact across the value chain were highly rated, with Fuji's Climate Change score improving 4 levels from the previous year's D to a B and the Water Security score improving 3 levels from the previous year's D to a B-.

Note: There are 8 levels (A, A-, B, B-, C, C-, D, D-).



### About CDP

CDP (Carbon Disclosure Project) is a global non-profit organization that operates the world's only independent environmental disclosure system, partnering with leaders in business, capital markets, policy, and science to provide information that enables Earth-positive decision making. In the 2024 survey that covered 24,800 companies worldwide, more than 2,100 Japanese companies responded, including 70% of the Tokyo Stock Exchange Prime Market listed companies.

## Fuji's efforts

The Fuji Group has identified “Contributing to a carbon neutral society” as one of its key material categories and is working to address decarbonization and expand its range of environmentally friendly products. The [mid-term business plan](#) that was announced in 2024 is one of Fuji’s key strategies to improving its business foundation based on ESG (Environment, Social and Governance). As part of this plan, in order to strengthen its organizational response to sustainability, Fuji has increased the number of personnel who can respond across divisions and has established a system to further promote the issue. Fuji is also collaborating with suppliers to implement activities to reduce carbon emissions and decrease the environmental impact across the entire value chain to reach the goal of a decarbonized society. Thanks to these initiatives, Fuji has seen an increase in CDP scores this year.

As environmental considerations become an important element of corporate activities, business operations that are focused on realizing a sustainable future through environmental considerations and value are needed more than ever. Fuji is aiming to achieve its [medium and long term environmental targets](#) for becoming carbon neutral and accelerating decarbonization activities. Being an integral part of customer supply chains, Fuji is committed to sharing the importance of environmental initiatives with its customers and supporting their sustainability efforts. Moreover, Fuji will continue to make the reduction of its environmental impact an important pillar of management, and work towards realizing a sustainable society while cooperating with internal and external stakeholders to promote decarbonization.
