

## Fuji Receives “A” Rating in CDP’s 2025 Supplier Engagement Assessment (SEA) for Its Supply Chain Decarbonization Initiatives

Fuji Corporation (headquarters: Chiryu, Aichi; Representative Director, President and CEO: Joji Isozumi; hereinafter referred to as "Fuji") has received an “A” rating in the 2025 Supplier Engagement Assessment (SEA) conducted by CDP\*, an international environmental disclosure system.

### What is the Supplier Engagement Assessment (SEA)?

The Supplier Engagement Assessment (SEA), conducted by CDP, is an indicator that evaluates how companies are addressing climate change within their supply chains. Companies are evaluated and ranked based on five key areas: Supplier engagement, Scope 3 emissions, risk management processes, governance and business strategy, and targets.



### Fuji's initiatives

Fuji has established a carbon neutrality strategy roadmap as part of its medium- and long-term environmental targets for the entire group, aiming to achieve an 80% reduction in CO<sub>2</sub> emissions per unit of sales by 2051 (compared to fiscal 2022 levels). To achieve this goal, Fuji is strengthening its initiatives by disclosing scope 3 emissions and supporting suppliers in visualizing and reducing CO<sub>2</sub> emissions across the entire supply chain. In the 2025 assessment, these initiatives led to an "A" rating.

### Towards the future

Fuji has identified “Future: Contributing to a carbon neutral society” as one of its key material categories and is working to address decarbonization not only within its own operations but across the entire supply chain. Going forward, Fuji will continue to collaborate with suppliers to promote decarbonization, while advancing the development of products that contribute to reducing greenhouse gas emissions, including environmentally conscious products featuring energy-efficient designs, solutions that improve last-mile delivery efficiency, and technologies that enhance the efficiency and stability of recycling. Through these efforts to reduce environmental impact, Fuji aims to enhance corporate value and contribute to the realization of a sustainable society.
